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10 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FY 2004-05 BUDGET BY REAPPROPRIATING
11 \$78,057 FROM NON-DEPARTMENTAL FOR THE PURPOSE OF AWARDING
12 GRANTS TO FAIRBANKS DRAMA ASSOCIATION AND CHILDREN'S THEATRE, INC.
13 (\$30,325), MECHANICAL CONTRACTORS OF FAIRBANKS, INC. (\$30,325), AND
14 NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CONTRACTORS ASSOCIATION, INC. (\$17,407),
15 TO MATCH FEDERAL FUNDS AWARDED FOR
16 STABILIZATION OF LAND PARCELS ON THE CHENA RIVERBANK

18 WHEREAS, the ceaseless natural dynamics of Alaska's rivers
19 occasionally require intervention to correct conditions which threaten wildlife habitat and
20 private and public property; and
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22 WHEREAS, such intervention in the form of riverbank stabilization is
23 needed immediately for three contiguous properties located at 1830, 1840 and 1852
24 Second Avenue, owned by Fairbanks Drama Association and Children's Theater, Inc.
25 (FDA), a non-profit corporation, Mechanical Contractors of Fairbanks, Inc. (MCF), and
26 the National Electrical Contractors Association, Inc. (NECA), respectively, hereinafter
27 collectively referred to as Owners; and

29 WHEREAS, the most effective riverbank stabilization is achieved by using
30 bioengineered, or living, bank techniques, which have proven most successful in
31 achieving habitat, environmental, and property protection goals, as well as providing
32 additional downstream bank protection through current-energy dispersal; and
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34 WHEREAS, the Owners, following a two-year process of assessments
35 and reviews, jointly submitted an application to the U.S. Department of Agriculture,
36 National Resource Conservation Service (NRCS), for riverbank stabilization grants; and
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38 WHEREAS, NRCS has approved \$234,172 in combined grant funding to
39 the Owners, representing 75% of the preliminary project estimate total (\$312,229); the
40 remaining 25%, or \$78,057, is to be contributed as match by the Owners; and
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42 WHEREAS, on July 10, 1997, the Fairbanks North Star Borough
43 (Borough) adopted the Chena Riverfront Plan (Ordinance No. 97-007); and
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45 WHEREAS, the plan encourages property owners to pursue appropriate
46 methods of riverbank stabilization using bioengineered techniques; and

48 WHEREAS, the Owners have executed grant agreements with NRCS for
49 75% of the estimated total cost of the bank stabilization project; and
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51 WHEREAS, the Owners have requested that the Borough provide the
52 25% required match on their behalf; and
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54 WHEREAS, completion of the project in 2005 is critical; and
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56 WHEREAS, under the budgetary guideline entitled "Non-Departmental" in
57 the FY2004-05 budget, funds were set aside as local match for grants received by
58 organizations that work for the betterment of the community.
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60 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Assembly of the Fairbanks
61 North Star Borough:
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63 Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is not of a general and
64 permanent nature and shall not be codified.
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66 Section 2. General Fund Appropriation. The FY 2004-05 budget is
67 hereby amended by reappropriating \$78,057 from the budgetary guideline entitled
68 "Awaiting Budget" to "Contractual Services" for the purpose of awarding Borough
69 Matching Grants (25%) to the following organizations:

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73 Section 3. Eligible Expenditure Period. Expenditures incurred within
74 the effective dates of the executed NRCS awards and Borough Matching Grant
75 agreements are eligible under this appropriation.
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
77 Section 4. Contingency. The \$78,057 appropriation is contingent upon
78 execution of NRCS Grant Awards (75%) and Borough Matching Grant (25%)
79 agreements with FDA, MCF, and NECA.

81 Section 5. Lapsing Funds. Upon completion of the grant project, any
82 unencumbered, unexpended funds will lapse to Non-Departmental Awaiting Budget.

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84 Section 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective at 5:00 p.m.
85 on the first Borough business day following its adoption.


