

## Group use policy

1. Lifeguards have the ultimate decision making authority and adults in attendance are expected to assist the lifeguards.
2. All members of the group must follow all pool rules. Only persons dressed for swimming are allowed on the pool deck, unless specifically given permission by the supervisor or lead guard.
3. The group leader must check in with the supervisor or lead guard upon arrival at the facility.
4. Young children in groups require extra supervision, which is the responsibility of the respective groups to provide. There must be 1 person age 16 or older, in the water, actively supervising no more than 4 children that are under the age of 6. There must be 1 person age 16 or older, in the water, actively supervising no more than 10 children that are between the ages of 6 and 10.
5. One person may supervise no more than 10 children total.
6. Children with known physical or behavioral limitations should have individual supervision in the water.
7. Children may not be left unattended in the facility. The group leader must stay with the group until all children have been picked up.
8. In order to provide the appropriate amount of staff and a safe environment, groups must schedule all swim dates and times at least 24 hours in advance with the Facility Supervisor.
